The entire event will take place on private land and public roads will not be used.

Jurisdiction

The meeting will be governed by the National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event.

1 Authorisations

Motorsport UK Clubman permit number **205687** has been issued.

2 Competitor Eligibility

The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, and members of AMSC member clubs. The event is a round of the Anglia Motor Sport Club Trials Challenge.

As part of the Motorsport UK StreetCar initiative, the event is running as a Taster Event. To encourage first timers to have a go, temporary club membership will be available for anyone not a member of a Motorsport UK recognised motor club. See Para 14 below for the minimum ages of competitors.

4 Classes

Entrants will compete in one of four classes. 4-wheel-drive vehicles (4WD) cannot compete.

Class 1/ FWD PRODUCTION CARS CARRYING NO BALLAST

Two-wheel drive production cars first registered on or after 1st January 1998, taxed for road use and, **driven to the venue**, carrying no ballast and having no modifications apart from:

- a/ Under-body protection weighing no more than 10kg (including fittings)
- b/ Replacement of wheels in accordance with NCRs Ch. 17, Appendix 4, Para 1.2/b
- c/ Replacement of tyres in accordance with NCRs Ch. 17, Appendix 4, Para 1.2/c

Which state that: Tyre sizes and aspect ratios are free providing they are compatible with UK Construction and Use Regulations for the vehicle concerned.

Class 2/ FWD PRODUCTION CARS

Front wheel drive production cars not eligible for Class 1

Class 3/ RWD PRODUCTION CARS AND SPORTS CARS

Class 4/ MODIFIED PRODUCTION CARS AND KIT CARS AND THOSE NOT QUALIFYING FOR CLASSES A, B or C

Class 5/ Sporting Trials cars may compete in their own class but are not eligible to score points in the AMSC Trials Challenge

Driver Experience:

N = Novice – never won an award on a Car Trial

E = Expert – all other drivers not classified as a Novice

REMINDER each entry requires a fully completed entry form – a straightforward double entry (driver only) will require the submission of two entry forms.

For clarification: passengers are optional, and a double entry means any entry where an individual or vehicle features in more than one entry.

The latest version of the Motorsport UK Clubmans Signing-on Form implies a form will be required for each driver and each passenger – a straightforward double entry with passenger will require the submission of four signing on forms.

5 Tyre Pressures

Minimum tyre pressure on driven wheels:

Class 1 FWD - 12 psi

Class 2 FWD - 14 psi

Class 3 RWD and Sports Cars
Front engine - 16 psi
Rear engine - 22 psi

Class 4 All cars - 20 psi

Any car fitted with a torque-biasing differential or any other form of traction control must use tyre pressures 4 psi higher than those specified above.

Due to ground conditions, tyre pressures may be altered on the day.

6 Tyres

The following Motorsport UK Regulations apply to all classes.

Use of the following tyres is prohibited

6.1/ Those having any of the following patterns, inscriptions or manufacturers' designations: - 'All Seasons', 'Winter', 'Grip', 'Snow', 'Special Use', 'Town & Country', 'Mud & Snow', 'M+S', 'M.S.', 'M&S', or the Three Peaks Mountain Snowflake

6.2/ Tyres constructed primarily for off-road use

6.3/ Tyres having additional tread grooves cut into them after manufacture.

6.4/ Goodyear All Weather Steel Radial, Goodyear Vector, Pirelli P7, Michelin XRN or Uniband Rally Steel.

For fire safety reasons, fully electric and electric-hybrid cars are not eligible for this event.

Classification of a vehicle will ultimately be at the discretion of the organisers.

7 Awards

There may be awards.

8 Entries

The entry fee is £35.00 per driver (or £10.00 if the driver is under 18).

11 Route, Format & Penalties

The entire event will take place within the confines of Cadder's Hill, Lyng.

It is planned that the event will have up to 36 observed sections, 3 runs at each hill in the morning and 2 or 3 runs at each hill in the afternoon.

Drivers will be identified by numbers which will be provided by the organisers.

The starting signal will be 'in your own time'.

Performance will be assessed as in NCRs Chapter 17, Appendix 2, Para 4. and Chapter 17, Appendix 7, Drawing 2.

12 Modifications to Motorsport UK's Regulations

All other National Competition Rules of Motorsport UK apply, except for the following which is modified: Posts or pylons may be less than 1 metre high.

13 Final Instructions

Final Instructions will be e-mailed during the week before the event, to the email address provided on the entry form.

14 Minimum Ages and Driving Licence Requirements

Entries may be accepted from drivers who are 14 and over. However, for drivers not holding a full RTA Licence, the passenger must hold a full RTA Licence and be experienced in trialling.

Passengers must be 12 years or over. However, for passengers not holding a full RTA licence, the driver must hold a full RTA Licence.

The SCCON club Micras will be available but must be booked on the entry form. As the club Micras are not taxed or MOT'd they will have to run in Class 2. To encourage less experienced crews to have a go, there will be the option to not be classified in the overall results, but performance will be measured against the other club Micras and if there are 3 or more entries there may be a 'best Micra' award. This does not exclude anyone using a club Micra from opting to compete in Class 2 and being classified in the overall results.
